TRANSCATHETER AORTIC VALVE IMPLANTATION (TAVI)

TAVI or TAVR is a minimally invasive procedure to replace a damaged aortic valve in the heart. It involves threading a new valve through a catheter and implanting it within the diseased valve, often avoiding the need for open-heart surgery. TAVI is a less invasive option for patients with aortic valve stenosis, leading to quicker recovery times and improved outcomes, particularly for those deemed high-risk or inoperable for traditional valve replacement.

DEEP BRAIN STIMULATION (DBS)

DBS implants electrodes in specific brain areas, akin to a pacemaker for the brain. DBS can help reduce the symptoms of tremor, slowness, stiffness, and walking problems caused by Parkinson's disease, dystonia, or essential tremor. Successful DBS allows people to potentially reduce their medications and dramatically improve their quality of life

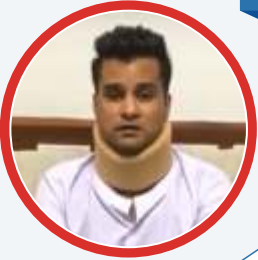


COMPUTER ASSISTED JOINT REPLACEMENT SURGERIES

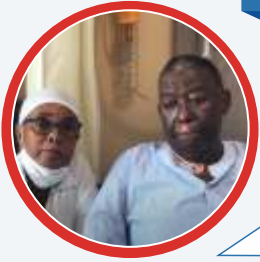

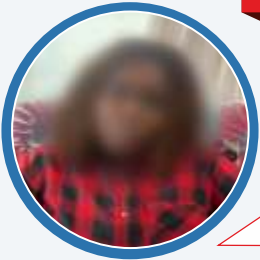

Mumbai docs give hope to Yemeni children with Cerebral Palsy

A 10-year-old Yemeni boy named Ali, who has cerebral palsy, is being treated at a hospital in Mumbai. His parents, who are from Yemen, are hoping for a better future for their son. The boy's condition is a neurological disorder that affects his ability to move and control his muscles. He has been in the hospital for several months, and his condition is improving. His parents are grateful for the care he is receiving.

Orthopedic surgeon Dr. Anil Bhaskar said he has treated at least five Yemeni children diagnosed with cerebral palsy. Two of them, Taha and Abdul Hakim, underwent surgery for contracture removal at Wockhardt Hospital. A contracture is a permanent shortening of a muscle or joint in a contracted muscle state. Doctors preserve top half of woman's skull in her abdomen

LIFE-SAVING Procedure reduces pressure on brain of accident victim, who will undergo skull reconstruction

A 27-year-old woman from India was admitted to a hospital with a severe head injury. The doctors performed a life-saving procedure to reduce the pressure on her brain. The procedure involved removing the top half of her skull and placing it in her abdomen. This allowed the pressure on her brain to decrease, and she was able to survive. She will undergo skull reconstruction surgery in a few weeks.

WHAT DOES THE SURGERY INVOLVE?

So we decided to perform the top half of the skull to allow the swelling of the brain to dissipate," said Dr. Bhat. The woman was then covered with a thin layer of skin. Doctors preserved the removed part of the skull in the patient's abdomen. The skull will be reconstructed after the patient has recovered. "Rather than using a prosthetic, we thought of preserving the original part of the skull. We could have preserved the skull by refrigerating it at a temperature below 8 degrees Celsius. But as we did not know how long it would take for the patient to recover, we stored it naturally. The skull was stored in a container with ice packs. Ex-MLA in city's second kidney-liver transplant

3 Simultaneous Surgeries Done Between 5am-3am Next Day

Mumbai: A former MLA from Latur district, Bhagwan Khandade, has become the second person in the city to undergo a simultaneous kidney and liver transplant in a south Mumbai hospital on December 21. Khandade got a kidney from his younger brother, who soon donated 65% of his liver. "We thus carried out three simultaneous surgeries between 5am and 3am the next day," said surgeons Anarag Shirmal and Gaurav Gupta, of Wockhardt Hospital near Mumbai Central station, who led a 15-member team for the transplants.

LOOKBACK AT FIRST CASE

The present case
Former MLA Bhagwan Khandade (62) from Latur got a kidney from his brother and a portion of liver from his nephew, at Wockhardt Hospital, Mumbai Central in December 2016.

A 50-year-old businessman from Malad, Hareesh Dhakan, was the first Mumbaier to undergo a dual transplant, thanks to his son and sister.

Fourteen surgeons from Global Hospital, Parel, carried out the three operations on October 1, 2014, transplanting a portion of 21-year-old Harshal's liver to his father and a kidney from 49-year-old Bina Soni to her brother.

As Khandade gets discharged on Tuesday he said, "Each one of us has to struggle, but we should take care to not over-exercise and give full attention to our health." Incidentally former chief minister Vilasrao Deshmukh who passed away in a Chennai hospital in 2012 for the want of an urgent liver-kidney transplant, also hailed from Latur. "We had in the past discussed our respective health conditions," added Khandade. Khandade said the diagnosis of a double transplant did not worry him because he had for decades counselled organ failure patients. "Moreover, I had six years to get used to the idea," he said.

Dr. Bhaskar added that it was due to the patient's diligence that he could manage without dialysis for three years despite having a significant kidney and liver failure.

Meanwhile, Dr. Ravi Mohankar from Global Hospital, Parel, who was a part of the team that carried out the city's first dual transplant in 2014, said the first patient was doing well. "Dual transplants are only needed by patients who have diabetes-related complications or kidney failure patients who acquire viral infections such as Hepatitis C during dialysis," he said.

Dr. Gussard Deras, who heads the Zonal Transplant Coordination Centre, said such cases underline the need for better cadaver donations. "If there are more cadaveric donations, we will be able to help such patients. You now have regulations in place that allow a patient with kidney and liver failure to get priority," said Dr. Deras, who is the medical director of HN Bellance Hospital in Ghatkopar.

Khandade said the government must ensure that less-potential donors are used in farms. "We should also ensure that everyone has better access to health-care with some insurance," he said, adding that he would work to spread the message of organ donations.
