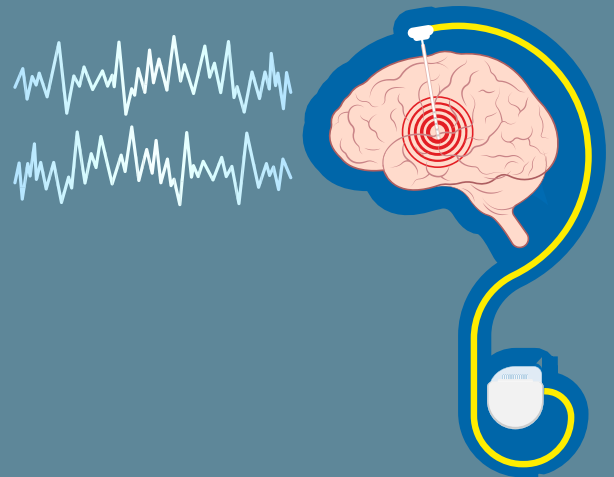


## TRANSCATHETER AORTIC VALVE IMPLANTATION (TAVI)

TAVI or TAVR is a minimally invasive procedure to replace a damaged aortic valve in the heart. It involves threading a new valve through a catheter and implanting it within the diseased valve, often avoiding the need for open-heart surgery. TAVI is a less invasive option for patients with aortic valve stenosis, leading to quicker recovery times and improved outcomes, particularly for those deemed high-risk or inoperable for traditional valve replacement.

## DEEP BRAIN STIMULATION (DBS)

DBS implants electrodes in specific brain areas, akin to a pacemaker for the brain. 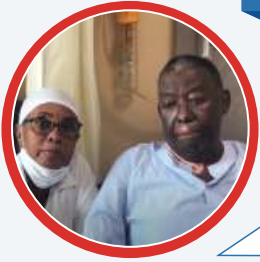

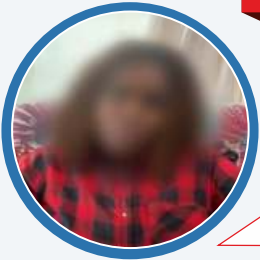

## GETTING BACK ON THEIR FEET

### Mumbai docs give hope to Yemeni children with Cerebral Palsy

A 21-year-old woman from Patna met with an accident that severely injured her brain. Her brain was massively enlarged owing to swelling from the injury.

The surgery, a decompressive craniectomy, was performed and doctors removed the top half of her skull.

The exposed part of the brain was covered with a thin layer of skin.

A tube was fit alongside the border to support the brain and avoid injuries.

Orthopaedic surgeon Dr. Atul Bhatkar said he has treated at least four Yemeni children diagnosed with cerebral palsy. Two of them, Taha and Abdul Rehman, underwent surgery for contracture removal at Wockhardt Hospital, Mira Road, last week.

A contractor is the permanent shortening of a muscle or joint in a concentrated muscle area.

"A year after he was born, we realised that he was not able to walk or stand properly. We stayed in Yawa, a small village. It takes us two days to reach the nearest hospital," said Mohammad.

The boy's families said the majority of Yemen's medical resources are focused on attending to the war.

"None of the hospitals we visited offered our children

physician or physiotherapist when they return home," said Dr Bhatkar.

In Yawa, there are about 25 children who are facing similar complications, but have no treatment options. The absence of an Indian Embassy, since the past four months, makes it difficult for families to get a medical visa to travel to India.

Rashmi Karim, a former Indian embassy employee, said she had helped 15 to 20 families get medical visas.

"My utmost has resulted in a scarcity of resources. A majority of the locals are farmers, they don't have the financial means to travel to India for treatment. But, now with non-governmental organisations such as Red Cross, donations are being brought to Mumbai, Pune and Bangalore for treatment," said Karim.

"Surgeries are only 40% of the work, the rest task is physiotherapy which helps strengthen the muscles so the children can stand and walk. We will train the families in physiotherapy, so they don't have to hunt for a professional

## Doctors preserve top half of woman's skull in her abdomen

**LIFE-SAVING** Procedure reduces pressure on brain of accident victim, who will undergo skull reconstruction

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### WHAT DOES THE SURGERY INVOLVE?

- A 21-year-old woman from Patna met with an accident that severely injured her brain.
- Her brain was massively enlarged owing to swelling from the injury.
- The surgery, a decompressive craniectomy, was performed and doctors removed the top half of her skull.
- The exposed part of the brain was covered with a thin layer of skin.
- A tube was fit alongside the border to support the brain and avoid injuries.
- Antibiotics were administered to reduce the swelling.
- Another small surgery was done to cut open her abdominal wall.
- Part of the skull was preserved in the wall and surgically closed.
- She has recovered and is living a normal life with an exposed brain.
- The top half of the skull is currently stored in her abdomen to preserve it. It will be reattached to her skull four months later.

was extensive. We put her on medication to reduce the swelling, but her condition kept deteriorating. So we decided to remove the top half of the skull to allow the swelling of the brain to occupy the cavity and reduce pressure," said Dr Bajaj. The brain was then covered with a thin layer of skin.

Doctors preserved the removed part of the skull in the patient's abdominal wall. Reconstruction of the skull will be carried out after the patient has recovered.

"Rather than using a prosthetic, we thought of preserving the original part of the skull. We could have preserved the skull by refrigerating it at a temperature lower than 8 degrees Celsius. But as we did not know how long it would take for the patient to recover, we stored it naturally."

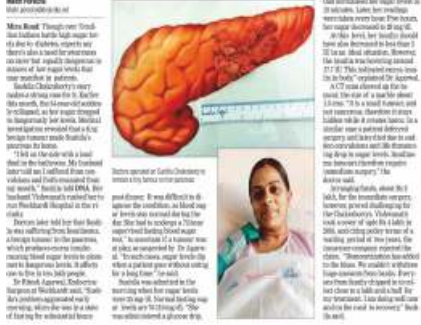

The tumour is usually small, but it produces a large amount of insulin, which causes the blood sugar to drop to very low levels. This can lead to symptoms such as sweating, shakiness, and confusion.

## Doctors perform rare pancreas surgery

A rare and complex surgical procedure was performed on a patient with a pancreatic tumour. The surgery involved the removal of a portion of the pancreas and the surrounding tissues.

The patient, a 65-year-old man, had been suffering from abdominal pain and weight loss for several months. Doctors discovered a large, irregular mass in the pancreas during a routine check-up.

The surgery was performed by a team of experts at Wockhardt Hospital, Mumbai. It was a highly complex procedure that required the removal of a significant portion of the pancreas and the surrounding tissues.

The patient is recovering well and is expected to be discharged from the hospital in a few days.

But it was only in the last six months that his condition worsened. "I withdrew from public life as was quite weak," said Khandade. His son was not a matching donor, but his brother and nephew were. "My brother needed help and I decided to give my kidney," said his

conditions," added Khandade. Khandade said the diagnosis of a double transplant did not worry him because he had for decades counselled organ failure patients. "Moreover, I had six years to get used to the idea," he said.

Dr Bahadur added that it was due to the patient's diligence that he could manage without dialysis for five years despite having a significant kidney and liver failure.

Meanwhile, Dr Ravi Mohanka from Global Hospital, Parel, who was a part of the team that carried out the city's first dual transplant in 2014, said the first patient was doing well. "Dual transplants are only needed by patients who have diabetes-related complications or kidney failure patients who acquire viral infections

such as Hepatitis C during dialysis," he said.

Dr. Gustav Daver, who heads the Zonal Transplant Coordination Centre, said such cases underline the need for better cadaver donations. "If there are more organ donor registrations, we will be able to help such patients. We now have regulations in place that allow a patient with kidney and liver failure to get priority," said Dr Daver, who is the medical director of HN Reliance Hospital in Girgaum.

Khandade said the government must ensure that less pesticides are used in farms. "We should also ensure that everyone has better access to healthcare with some insurance," he said, adding that he would work to spread the message of organ donations.
