


TRANSCATHETHER AORTIC VALVE IMPLANTATION (TAVI)

TAVI or TAVR is a minimally invasive procedure to replace a damaged aortic valve in the heart. It involves threading a new valve through a catheter and implanting it within the diseased valve, often avoiding the need for open-heart surgery. TAVI is a less invasive option for patients with aortic valve stenosis, leading to quicker recovery times and improved outcomes, particularly for those deemed high-risk or inoperable for traditional valve replacement.

DEEP BRAIN STIMULATION (DBS)

DBS implants electrodes in specific brain areas, akin to a pacemaker for the brain. DBS can help reduce the symptoms of tremor, slowness, stiffness, and walking problems caused by Parkinson's disease, dystonia, or essential tremor. Successful DBS allows people to potentially reduce their medications and dramatically improve their quality of life





COMPUTER ASSISTED JOINT REPLACEMENT SURGERIES

Mumbai: A former MLA from Laturdistrict, Bhagwan Khan-dade, has become the second person in the city to undergo a simultaneous kidney and liver transplant in a south Mumbai

hospital on December 21.

Khandade got a kidney from his younger brother, whose son donated 65% of his liver.

"We thus carried out three simultaneous supports bother. multaneous surgeries betwe-en 5am and 3am the next day." said surgeons Amurag Shrimal and Gaurav Gupta, of Wock-hardt Hospital near Mumbai Central station, who led a 15-member team for the trans-

Khandade was diagnosed with kidney failure in 2010. "He had an Hepatitis B infection and was being worked up for a transplant in 2013, when we found he had liver failure too," und he had giver rainure too, sald nephrologist and trans-plant physician, Dr Madan Ba-hadtur, who has been treating Khandadesince 2010.
But it was only in the last six months that his condition worsened. "I withdrew from nublic lifeas! was online weak."

Dr Gustad Daver, who he-

ads the Zonal Transplant Coorads the Zonal Transplant Coor-dination Centre, said such ca-ses underline the need for bet-ter cadaver donations. "If the-re are more cadaveric donations, we will be able to help such patients. We now ha-ter regulations in place that al. ve regulations in place that allow a patient with kidney and liver failure to get priority," sa-id Dr Daver, who is the medical

id Dr Daver, who is the medical director of HNReliance Hospi-tal in Girgaum. Khandade said the govern-ment must ensure that less pes-ticides are used in farms. "We should also ensure that everyone has better access to healthcare with some insurance," he said, adding that he would work to spread the message of organ donations.
